Background

The Southwestern Oregon Workforce Investment Board (SOWIB) is a non-profit organization serving as the local workforce development board for Coos, Curry, and Douglas Counties. SOWIB's mission is to develop, oversee, and implement the area's strategic plan for workforce development and allocate federal and other resources to appropriate workforce development activities and services, as prescribed in the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).

Overview

SOWIB is seeking a contractor or small crew to provide **basic setup and assembly services** for various projects across its service area. Tasks may include assembling, moving, installing, or adjusting items as needed to support ongoing initiatives.

Scope of Work

- Assemble, set up, and secure furniture, shelving, or modular units
- Transport and deliver items across the SOWIB service area
- Disassemble and reassemble materials as needed
- Unpack, install, and ensure functionality of pre-purchased equipment

Submission Requirements

Interested parties must submit:

- Availability and service area
- Hourly or project-based rates (Not to exceed \$5,000 total within a six-month period)
- Summary of relevant experience
